

# **TREK COIN CHALLENGE**



## **HISTORY:**

**In World War I, the coin made it's debut to authenticate an individual's association to a group or organization. The coin was exchanged during a personal meeting to verify the legitimacy of the other party. Since its existence, the coin has become a symbol of Camaraderie and "Esprit to Corps"**

**To keep with tradition, each individual who successfully completes the TREK earns a coin to signify their personal accomplishment and association with the SPECIAL OPS SERIES.**

## **RULES:**

- 1. Only those who have earned the SPECIAL OPS TREK Coin may participate.**
- 2. A TREK COIN Challenge can be initiated at any time.**
- 3. Challenge starts when the TREK Coin is slapped on a table / bar or by continuous tapping of the coin on a surface. Accidentally dropping a TREK Coin is a deliberate action and is considered a challenge.**
- 4. Everyone present at the time of the challenge must present his or her TREK Coin with 10 seconds. Each person challenged can take 1 step to get the coin.**
- 5. Those who fail to present the TREK Coin MUST buy a round of drinks for the Challenger and everyone who has their coin.**
- 6. If everyone challenged produces a TREK Coin, then the Challenger MUST buy a round of drinks for everyone.**
